The MassMATCH AT School Share is a secure website and database that permits descriptive listings of assistive technology to be entered, edited, removed, searched and managed. The MassMATCH program, Maximizing Assistive Technology in Consumers Hands, is the sponsor of this AT School Share project. MassMATCH does not profit from the loan, exchange or sale of listed devices.



It is the responsibility of the registered authorized user who lists a device to provide accurate and detailed information about the device and its condition for the benefit of any potential borrower or user. It is understood that authorized representatives from each school, district, or collaborative will maintain accurate detailed listings and provide timely management of inquiries and transactions. Federal reporting requirements and validity of your school reports depend on this accuracy. The role of MassMATCH is limited to sharing approved information, managing listings, and collecting generic data.

MassMATCH reserves the right to edit or refuse registrations and listings based on the information submitted by a user. Listings should not identify students who use or have a need for AT.

MassMATCH is continuing to develop and fine-tune the ATSS web site and its functionality so that it best serves the AT School Share community. Registered users participate as “beta-testers” and can expect to be contacted for feedback and for recommendations for how to improve the program. MassMATCH may solicit feedback by phone and/or email.
